This Woodinville winery gets big points from wine-loving couples, who love that they can see the winemaking facilities through the glass walls of the reception space. It gets even more points from earth-loving couples who love that the winery complies with a strict set of regulations to respect the salmon run and wetlands of the area. And pretty much everyone loves the groomed outdoor spaces and bocce ball court. Couples can wed in the garden and celebrate afterwards in the Terrace Room, a contemporary and austere space that extends into the adjacent tasting room and the gardens, which feature an outdoor fireplace and native plants. And since wine lovers tend to also be food lovers, the full-time on-site chef prepares seasonal menus using organic produce from Carnation's Oxbow Farm. What's not to love?

What makes it green: Designated Salmon Safe; maximized use of natural light; option of using linens made from recycled water bottles. Know before you book: Couples who want an outdoor wedding here need to book well in advance; the summer months fill up fast. *
